IMPROVED INTERCHANGE FILING SEARCH

In an effort to continue providing quality service to the citizens of Texas, the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) is pleased to announce the launch of its improved Interchange Filing Search. Located on the PUCT website, the tool is provided for the convenience of the public. In response to user feedback, the updated search tool includes:

- **Improved user interface.** The responsive design will work better on mobile browsers
- **Expanded access.** The following restrictions have been removed:
 - The 92-day date range restriction for Filings searches
 - The 5-day date range restriction for Daily Filings searches
- **Relevant sorting.** When doing a Style search, results are sorted by docket (control) number instead of Search Ranking. Results can also be sorted by any of the category columns.
- **Greater flexibility.** Results are now exportable to Excel
- **Increased user friendliness.** Instructional/explanatory text has been added to improve usability.

NOTE; The old search interface will be maintained in parallel for approximately 30 days in order to ensure a smooth transition to the new application.
